<u>Catherine Glenn Foster</u> – As President and CEO of Americans United for Life (AUL), the prolife legal organization that has been involved in every pro-life case before the U.S. Supreme Court since Roe v. Wade, Foster leads AUL in a mother-child strategy that looks at the interests and vulnerabilities of both.

She is admitted to the bar in Washington D.C. and Virginia, as well as the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia, the U.S. Courts of Appeals for the 1st, 5th, 8th, and 9th Circuits, and the U.S. Supreme Court.

<u>Rita Gitchell</u> - Attorney Gitchell's expertise has been called on by the Thomas More Society to help with several amicus briefs to bring the court's attention to the legal status of human embryos in such cases as *Szarfranski v. Dunston* on behalf of the American Association of Prolife Obstetricians and Gynecologists, and other embryo custody dispute cases where she has authored briefs, including: *Loeb v. Vergara, (Ca.); McQueen v. Gadberry, (Mo.); Karungi v. Ejalu (Mi.) and Rooks v. Rooks, (Co.).*

Gitchell has been admitted to practice law in Illinois and Michigan and before the U.S. Supreme Court.

<u>Former St. Sen Len Suzio</u> – Senator Suzio was elected twice to serve in the Connecticut State Senate representing the people of the 13th State Senate district, encompassing Cheshire, Meriden, Middlefield, and Middletown. Prior to his election, Suzio was a longtime pro-life activist.
